English is the medium of instruction for the courses unless otherwise stated. Other languages may be used during individual coaching sessions.

Examination Centre And Qualifications

FIS is an authorized exam center for various international education systems, including IELTS, Cambridge IGCSE, and Cambridge International A-Level. It is also a UCAS-accredited application center for top UK universities.

Attendance

The Singapore Immigration and Checkpoints Authority requires international students to maintain a monthly attendance rate of no less than 90%.

Class Size

The majority of classes have about 20-35 students.

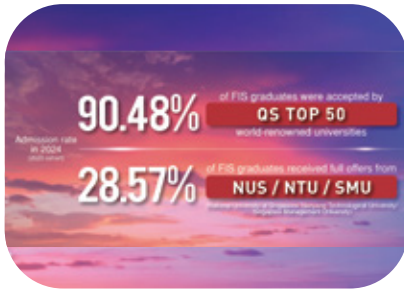


Extensive class hours and Comprehensive Teaching

FIS operates from 9 AM to 6 PM, offering a longer school day than most schools in Singapore. While public schools typically run from before 7:30 AM to between 3 PM and 6 PM, and international schools from around 8 AM to 4 PM, FIS extends its hours to ensure a more comprehensive and supportive learning experience.

A key component of this extended schedule is our academic **Mentoring System, which runs daily from 4 PM to 6 PM**. It is designed to help students reinforce their subject understanding through personalised academic guidance.

Outstanding University Admission Results

In 2024, **90.48%** of FIS 2023 graduates received unconditional offers from **QS Top 50 universities**, while **88.1%** secured offers from universities ranked in the **QS Top 30**.

Notably, **26.19%** of the graduating cohort received unconditional offers from Singapore's top local universities— **NUS and NTU**.

Grade-based Banding of English Lessons

Each term, students take a standardized **English proficiency exam** and are placed into one of three streams based on their learning needs. This approach ensures that students receive tailored teaching suited to their current skill level, and allows progress to happen effectively and confidently as students build their English language abilities. In the future they will be well-prepared for university life, where strong English proficiency is essential for both daily communication and academic success.

Dedicated Form Teachers

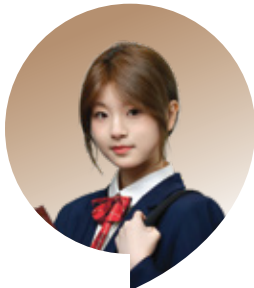

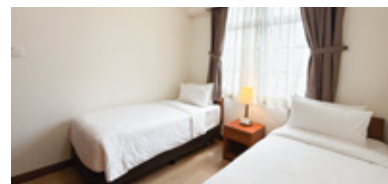

School-Sanctioned Hostel

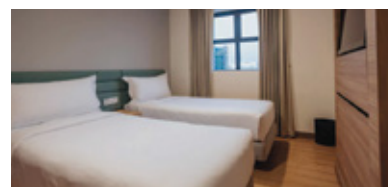
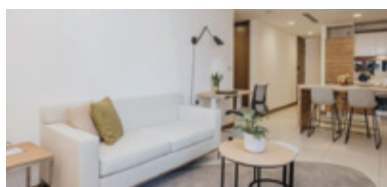
