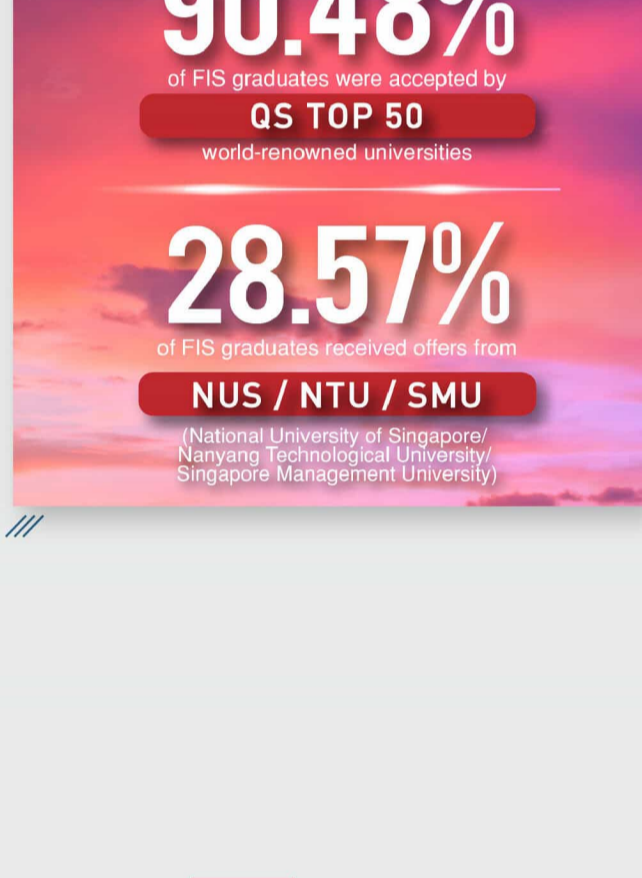
HIGHLIGHTS OF OCTOBER
